What is your most memorable gift-opening moment?

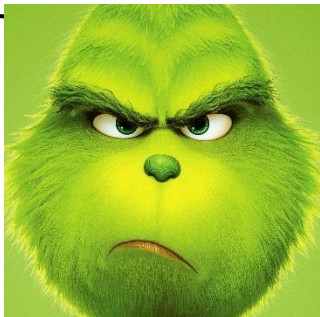
When you shut your eyes and imagine your "happy place," where is it?
